SCHEDULE

SATURDAY

Please arrive 60-45 min. before your start time

headlamp required for ALL participants

6:00PM - Packet Pickup/Texas Outlaw Pop-Up Store

8:00PM - All Races START

SSUNDAY

4:30AM - Cutoff for all races (8.5 hours)

RUCK Weight requirements:

- If you weigh more than 150 lbs = 30 lb. Ruck

- If you weigh less than 150 lbs = 20 lb. Ruck

*Ruck Sack or Vest are allowed

GENERAL INFO

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

The start and finish line will be located at the Guadalupe River State Park "River Overlook Trailhead." When entering the State Park you will pass by the headquarters. Keep straight. Continue straight to the end of the road then take a left into the parking lot.

RESTROOMS

We will have portable restrooms available outside the start/finish area.

MEDICAL

We will be using nearby public medical personnel. PLEASE CALL 911 in case of an emergency.

PARKING & DAY PASS

Day pass fees are to be paid to Guadalupe River State Park. They may write tickets if you do not have your pass visible in your windshield. You can pay \$7 online beforehand or pay cash on the day of the event. When arriving to the park please park in the parking lot at the event end of the road.

RACE TIMING

We will utilize the UltraSignup timing software (manual time.) We will time you using your bib number so please make sure your bib number is visible on the front of your body.

AID STATIONS

We will have one aid station available at the start/finish area.

Main Aid Station (0/5.2)

- hot/cold foods, snacks, water, electrolytes, pickle juice & ice





IMPORTANT

DROP BAGS

We allow drop bags at the start/finish area. Runners are responsible for their own drop bags and can set them anywhere out of the way.

BIBS

Please make sure that the bib number is visible and on the front of your body. We will use your bib number to identify you and record your time.

PACERS

Only 1 Pacer Per Runner and only allowed in last 2 loops of the 50K ([Signup Here](#))

PARKING

Please park in designated parking spaces only - if you park on the grass, then it is a federal citation.

PARK HOURS

- **Park gates to get in close at 10PM and open at 8AM, you can still get out between those hours.**
- Please respect park quiet hours when running through campgrounds between 10PM and 6AM.

DAY PASSES

ALL people entering the park are required to get a day pass - [Click Here](#)

- If day passes are sold out online, be prepared to pay for a pass at the gate on race day (\$7-\$10)

CAMPING

[Park Campgrounds](#) (3-5 min. from start/finish) - Campgrounds are \$`20/per night. There are restrooms & showers near campsites.

RUNNING IN THE DARK

Make sure to bring a head lamp - sunset is at 8:45PM.

CUPLESS RACE

To reduce waste out on the trails and in general we follow the cupless race protocol. This means that we will not serve any cups at aid stations for drinks. Please bring your own water carrying system.

COURSE MAP

8K = 1 LOOP | 25K = 3 LOOPS | 50K = 6 LOOPS

COURSE PROFILE

The Fire Trail Running Festival is a trail run at night that includes 8K, 25K, and 50K distances through the scenic grasslands and woodlands of Guadalupe River State Park.





COURSE MARKINGS



The trails will consist of orange signage, flagging (and yellow red reflective tape on the orange signs for the runners in the dark) as seen above. The orange signage and flags will also be seen throughout the course at intersections to show you where to go.

RACE RULES

TRAIL RUNNING RULES

- **Headlamps are required.**
- Park gates to get in close at 10PM & Open at 8AM, you can still get out between those hours.
- No Littering (If caught disqualification will occur.)
- Runners must follow the marked course and no cutting the course.
- Runners must have their phones on them, on, etc during the race.
- Race cutoff will be enforced.
- Be aware of your surroundings. You're partially in the wilderness, there can be wild animals/snakes.
- Please be respectful to all volunteers, race staff, and other race personnel.
